

WHRW Logs Test

Fall 2022

You are expected to fill out the logs completely and include all actions that would occur during a normal broadcast over a specific period of time, regardless of whether you are alerted to those actions or events on this test page. That includes carts you may have to play every hour. **Do exactly what you would do if you were actually on air.**

Use the current date for the test. Assume sunset is at 7:44 PM.

Unless otherwise noted, a normal set of readings for Power and Lights are 100% and 3%, respectively.

When a new person takes over the board, fill out the logs as that person.

- **8:00 AM.** You turn on the transmitter. You take the appropriate actions and begin your music show.
- **10:46 AM.** You start to play Tarkus, a 20 minute long track. Log all appropriate information.
- **12:00 PM.** You leave to go home. There is no DJ on air after you.
- **1:00 PM.** Claire Devlin comes in for her music show.
- **1:10 PM.** Claire is contacted by workers on the Library tower roof asking them to turn down the transmitter power to 19%. She takes appropriate actions.
- **2:00 PM.** The workers on the roof call Claire and tell her it is safe to raise the transmitter to normal levels. She does so.
- **3:30 PM.** Noah Smith starts a news show called “The News Show.” He plays an intro that lasts for 60 seconds.
- **4:00 PM.** Noah stays on to engineer a PA show called, “Star Lores”.
- **4:05 PM.** Noah plays the Kirby Choking PSA, a Moefest Promo, and the Crumb Feedback cart.
- **4:29 PM.** Becca Appel comes to engineer a PA show called, “Social Work Now!” The show lasts until 5:00 PM.
- **5:00 PM.** Becca stays on for her music show, “Lace Code.”
- **5:45 PM.** Becca plays a song by King Gizzard and the Lizard Wizard that has the word “fuck” in it. Act accordingly.
- **6:00 PM.** You return to start a music show.
- **6:45 PM.** You play a Rise Against song with racy lyrics, but no obscenities. Act accordingly.
- You take sunset readings at the appropriate time. You notice the tower lights at 0% and visually confirm this. As you act accordingly, the tech director tells you to write “Tower Lights 0%. FAA NOTAM #1966 Filed.” in the carrier notes.
- **11:30 PM.** Dan Treadway comes in for his music show, “Mad Sounds” It lasts until 1:00 AM.
- **12:03 AM.** Dan plays the Boblin the Goblin Station ID. It runs for 60 seconds.
- **1:00 AM.** Moe takes over for their music show, they do a verbal SI.
- **2:19 AM.** Moe takes scheduled readings but the transmitter power is above the acceptable range. They attempt the appropriate solution, **but it doesn’t work**. They act accordingly.
