\*\*\*A list of Trigger Examples:
Gore/Body Horror
ED related triggers (food, etc.)
Death
Mental Health (suicide, depression, etc.)
Volume
Aggressive Speaking/Tones
Physical Actions (throwing, stomping, etc.)
In general, it's up to your judgement when to explain or warn the group if you will be acting out anything that may be questionable
